Word Grid

Materials:

Paper
Pen/Pencil



Directions:

Each student draws a grid on a sheet of paper with 5 across and 5 down.

The first player calls out a letter. Everyone has to put the letter somewhere in their grid. Each person takes a turn at calling out letters until all the squares in the grid are filled in. The players count the number of words on their grid. The words can be found either horizontally or vertically. The words can be 2 to 5 letters long. You cannot use a word that can be counted as 2 words. Example: NOTE can either be counted as NOT or NOTE. It cannot be counted as both.

Scoring:

5 letter words = 10 points
4 letter words = 6 points
3 letter words = 3 points
2 letter words = 2 points
